Rural communities, especially youth and women, lack access to SAM, despite its benefits. Few FAO FFS projects currently include SAM.

The Goal:

Integrate SAM into FFS to reduce labor, increase efficiency, boost yields and incomes, and foster innovation among small-scale producers.

Who Can Apply:

FAO Country Offices with FFS projects are invited to apply by June 26, 2024. Selected offices will receive financial grants, capacity development, and connections with global experts.
