**Nutrition Research Facility (NRF) Webinar - January 28** 

Current knowledge on micronutrient supplementation: policies,

practices, and impacts.

Micronutrient deficiencies remain a persistent challenge, especially among pregnant women, posing risks to pregnancy outcomes and child development. This webinar will highlight the critical importance of micronutrient supplementation offering insights into global policies, evidence-based practices, and findings from recent research. Regarding the long-term effects of multiple micronutrient supplementation on child cognitive development, a recent systematic review by the NRF concludes

that evidence is still lacking.
