

The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and CGIAR will host the official Food and Agriculture Pavilion at the 2024 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP29) to be held from November 11-22, in Baku, Azerbaijan.

The 29th Conference of Parties (COP29) will focus on advancing the goals of the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement, discussing global efforts to limit warming, adapt to climate impacts, and mobilize financing.

Key meetings include COP29, CMP 19 (Kyoto Protocol), and CMA 6 (Paris Agreement). At the Food & Agriculture Pavilion, CGIAR and FAO will foster dialogue on the role of agriculture in climate action, showcasing strategies to reduce emissions, adapt food systems, and secure resources for vulnerable communities.

The Nutrition Research Facility (NRF) has launched a call for expression of interest for a Junior non-key expert – Research assistant, to assist the implementation of the NRF research study (21.004) - Understanding the persistence of malnutrition in the Sahel - Study A: Drivers of persistent high rates of undernutrition in the Sahel, specifically the case studies in Burkina Faso and Niger to conduct qualitative longitudinal analyses based on interviews with different actors.

The research study aims to investigate the influence of contextual and structural/systemic drivers on reducing the “implementation effectiveness” of nutrition interventions in the Sahel. The position is aimed to provide backstopping support for the implementation of activities in the field. Travels to Burkina Faso and Niger might be necessary as part of this assignment.
