Rapporteur's Report

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Five key issues to be tackled

- 1. Food security & nutrition in conflict areas (migration; strengthen women's rights, integrate men)
- 2. In research, integrate: *a*) diverse actors, knowledge systems, data (metrics, models, natural/social sciences, basic/applied research); *b*) transdisciplinary/participatory approaches for balanced agenda & dialogue; *c*) diverse funding structures; <u>long-term planning</u>!
- 3. How can we make agriculture (large & small) more ecologically sound, adaptive and resilient? (link producers consumers; strengthen producers' access to markets, resources, services econ. viability)
- 4. Transform food systems: *a)* role of social movements to challenge concentration of power; *b)* role of governance/institutions for translation of policies at national/sub-national level
- 5. Shift consumption patterns towards sustainable diets: a) address all forms of malnutrition (incl. overnutrition); b) link agriculture nutrition; c) awareness, education; d) cultural aspects
